Riders of all ages and any seat. Open to all quarter horses with breed characteristics - judge has the right to excuse entries.

Color Breed Division

CB

Riders of all ages and any seat. Open to all color breeds with breed characteristics - judge has the right to excuse entries.

Draft and Heavy Breed Division

HB

Riders of all ages and any seat. Open to all draft breeds/crosses.

Saddle Seat Division

SS

Riders of all ages and horses of any breed.

Open English Walk Trot

OEWT

All ages for anyone that cannot canter for any reason.

Lead Line Division

LL

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Handler must be over 14 years old.

Open Pleasure Driving

OD

All ages and all breeds.

All Around Performance Horse

AA

This is a weekend award that will be given to the horse accumulating the highest number of points showing in all classes listed with an AA next to it

BWTC

Riders of all ages. Riders in their first or second year catering or loping at shows.

SIV

*Open to all ages and breeds in memory of a true versatile horse, Miss Muffin.
Attire and tack must match the class description.*

LLAA

Riders of all ages who for any reason needs to be lead and cannot ride without a handler. Handler must be at least 18 years of age.

2016 Blandford Fair Horse Show Rules

- ◆ Rider age is as of January 1st 2016
- ◆ COGGINS shown the day of show
 - Out of State Horses: negative coggins within the past 6 months.
 - In State Horses: negative coggins within one year.
- ◆ Once a class is entered, it must be paid for. Scratches are not allowed unless there is injury to horse or rider.
- ◆ The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes.
- ◆ All classes will run in accordance with AQHA/USEF rules.
- ◆ Chaps **are** allowed on all western riders, in all mounted classes.
- ◆ If the committee approves, a class may be held for 2 minutes.
- ◆ Breed classes do not require registration paperwork. However, the horse must exhibit breed characteristics and the judge may ask to see proof of breed if an issue arises.
- ◆ Unruly and/or abusive horses or people will be asked to leave the show grounds.
- ◆ Stallions must be shown by exhibitors over the age of 19. They must also wear a green ribbon in their tail.
- ◆ All kickers and mares in heat must be shown with a visible red ribbon in their tail.
- ◆ Horses must be ridden at a walk outside of designated areas.
- ◆ All riders 18 and under must wear an ASTM approved helmet while mounted on the fairgrounds.
- ◆ No person shall approach the judge at any time. Questions and concerns must be brought to the show booth. Ignoring this rule could lead to disqualification.
- ◆ There will be a \$40.00 bounced check fee.
- ◆ Classes are placed 1st through 6th with points as follows:
(1st) 7 – (2nd) 5 – (3rd) 4 – (4th) 3 – (5th) 2 – (6th) 1
- ◆ Day end awards are based on same horse and rider combo. You **MUST** enter all classes in your division to qualify for day end championships.
- ◆ A tie will be broken by the show judge.
- ◆ Stakes Class Payback: 1st (50%) - 2nd (25%) - 3rd (15%) - 4th (10%)
- ◆ CLASSICS are open to all, with special awards for each class.
- ◆ You must present your 4-H card in order to get the 4-H discount.
- ◆ Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
